A CAR BIOGRAPHY GT FALCON LICENCE 70386H

My early days are a little vague, I was built in 1969 with a 351 Windsor motor, spending a number of years in Western NSW.

In the mid 1980s I changed owners and moved to Queensland's Sunshine Coast. During that time a few changes were made:

- 1. A change of colour from Diamond White to Vintage Burgundy
- A change of gearbox from Automatic to manual.
- 3. Some internal modifications to the motor.

In 2000, I was again put up for sale at a used car yard in Strathpine. My current owner happened to spot me by chance and could not resist the temptation to make enquiries. The salesman and my soon to be new owner had differing opinions as to whether I was genuine or a replica. When that was settled my new home became the Northern Rivers.

Shortly after moving to my new home, I had an unfortunate experience. I was on my way to a show and shine at the Lismore airport on a wet and foggy Saturday morning when I came up behind a slow moving vehicle. My new owner attempted to overtake this vehicle on a slight corner and got his ambitions and his capabilities confused. This resulted in me facing in the opposite direction in a ditch covered in red mud. Needless to say, I had to return home to be hosed down before attending the show. Over the years I have been to countless car shows with the club.

Over a period of time and only doing low mileage, my tyres became very hard and dangerous on wet roads. My owner decided they needed to be replaced, but would try to wear them out first. I was entered in the "Drags" at Casino.

The tyres had very little grip and as a consequence I won hardly any races. However, the crowd enjoyed the spectacle as I was able to smoke the tyres the full length of the track. The tyres were still not worn out, but were replaced for safety reasons.

These days I spend most of my time in the garage. although it is good to get out on the highway and mix it with the modern computerised machines. I still have what it takes after 55 years, to keep up with and beat many.

I am very doubtful that I will change ownership again and feel that I will be with my current owner until his demise.
