The Club needs a delegate to the CHMC Meetings, and observers may also attend. We need to advise CHMC of who the Delegate is, and how many other Club members will be attending.

Nominations will be taken at the coming meeting.

### SAT NOV 23<sup>rd</sup> PAMC REGISTRATION DAY

Similar operational arrangements to last year, but happening a few weeks earlier. The Club's Registration day has been set as Saturday November 23<sup>rd</sup>.

This is the only Registration Day.

Although Registration renewals are most unlikely to have been received from TfNSW, the Club process can be carried out using the current (2024) registration papers.

Inspections will commence at 8.00am at Western Road Liners Depot in Danilenko St Parkes. For safety reasons we will limit the numbers of vehicles in the Depot at any one time, with vehicles generally waiting parked in Danilenko St.

There will be a Marshall at the gate, and once the maximum numbers are inside, it will be a case of "one out, one in". Not all that different to what has happened for the past year or so.

Last year, concern was felt that only about one third of vehicles were presented on Registration day, the remainder being subject to individual inspections after the event. This is not in the spirit of having a Club Day and posts an additional and unwarranted load on the Club's Inspection team.

A suggestion has been made that Registration Day be expanded to be an occasion for Club day for family, fellowship and interaction, by having a barbecue conducted on the sidelines, and the day extended beyond the usual 11.00am closure. The idea proposes that, say, Bacon and Egg Rolls be served until about 9.30; morning tea until about 11.30; and a Sausage Sizzle from 11.30 onwards. Tea and Bickies could be available the whole day.

This would provide an opportunity for those with work commitments on Saturday morning to be present, together with allowing more time for those with a number of vehicles to get more than one or two inspected.

Vehicles registered under the Conditional Registration Scheme (club plates) must be inspected by Club Eligibility Committee members, even if a safety inspection is carried out elsewhere, such as at an TfNSW Authorised Inspection Station.

Vehicle Inspection is a valuable service provided by our voluntary Inspectors, and the advice they give is intended to be in the best interests of both the vehicle owner and the Club as a whole. Please make their job easier by doing your bit to check your vehicle's roadworthiness beforehand, particularly if your vehicle had an area of weakness pointed out last year. Should you have the safety inspection carried out at an Authorised Inspection Station or by prior

arrangements with one of the Club's inspectors, make sure that either one of the inspectors has seen it, or is confident enough that it still conforms to HVS provisions before you get one of the "Responsible Persons" to sign off the TfNSW paperwork.

Notwithstanding any inspection, it is the driver's responsibility to ensure that a vehicle is in a safe condition to use at any time. Don't put our voluntary inspectors in the embarrassing position of having to recommend that your vehicle be knocked back because you didn't fix up something obvious, or not attended to something they have previously drawn to your attention.

### RECENT RMS CHANGES

- We can now have more than one Responsible Person (the Club Member who can "sign off" on Registration documents).
- RMS requires us to have an Eligibility Committee, which checks any documents the authenticity of any vehicle proposed for the HVS.
- Police are prepared to take action against individuals who make false declarations relating to vehicle registrations. (Police have very limited ability to act against Clubs).

PAMC has procedures within its By Laws to document and provide a paper trail of its inspections of both vehicle eligibility and roadworthiness.

At the Annual General Meeting in November, there may need to be some minor additions or alterations to the people elected to oversee vehicle eligibility and roadworthiness and make the necessary certifications to TfNSW (the Registration Authority)

Contrary to notions held by many people involved in the Heritage Vehicle Movement, TfNSW/RMS can not take actions against individuals, only Clubs, What this means is that if a member transgresses the rules associated with the Historic Vehicle Scheme, it is a Police matter in the first instance.

TfNSW is aware of Police activities and can act against a Club (for example suspending eligibility to be part of HVS/CVS) where there appears to be repeat offenders in that particular Club.

### Parkes Christmas Street Parade Conditions and Guidelines 2024

- All floats must be decorated in a Christmas theme.
- All floats must be preregistered to participate in the parade.
- The maximum length of any vehicle including towed additions must not exceed
- 12.5m. Maximum height is 4.3m. Maximum width is 3.5m.
- All drivers must be appropriately licensed for the type of vehicle being driven.

- All motorcyclists are to hold a Class R license.
- Articulated vehicles are not permitted in the Street Parade. Light vehicles towing trailers are permitted.
- Official Street Parade identification to be displayed clearly.
- Float participants are not permitted to spray or squirt water or throw or handout any items during the parade.
- Smoking or the consumption of alcohol is not permitted in the parade. The Street Parade passes through an alcohol-free zone.
- Children participating in the Street Parade must be supervised by a responsible adult aged over 18.
- Floats carrying people must include a handrail or stabilising bar for the safety of the float's participants.
- All passengers including children and babies must be restrained when riding in a vehicle.
- While entrants are restricted to a <10kmh speed limit they are also required to maintain a constant speed and to not come to a stop or create excessive space between their float and the entry in front.
- All vehicles must have a nominated float supervisor and driver who will be responsible
  for ensuring all participants are briefed to ensure the care and control of all passengers
  and materials.
- Parkes Shire Council and Parkes Police reserve the right to remove any entries that are deemed unsuitable or that contravene these conditions.
- Participants are to indemnify Parkes Shire Council against any claim which may arise directly from this activity.
- Entries must be received no later than Friday 17th November 2023.
