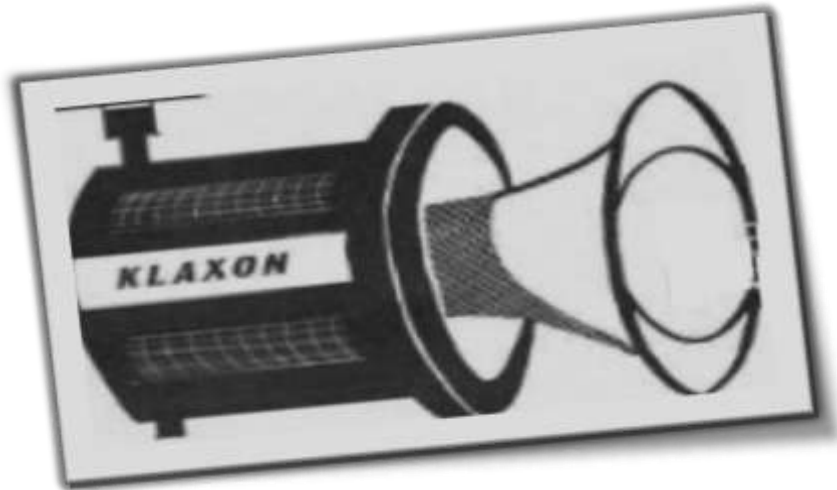

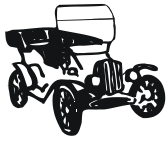
### GUIDELINES FOR CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION (CLUB PLATES)

All NRVVCC members should familiarize themselves with the NSW RMS rules and club rules surrounding how to use your vehicles on Conditional registration, together with the requirement to carry certain documents in the vehicle whenever it is being used.

If you are on the log book trial, the RMS issued log book must be completed by the member before you use the vehicle for anything **other than** NRVVCC club outings. Vehicles **not on log book**, the member should phone/email the secretary when a movement is needed for anything **other than** club outings.

Any member with vehicles(s) conditionally registered through the NRVVCC and who do not attend a **minimum of three club events per calendar year** (not including registration day & meetings) may be asked by the committee to show cause as to why the club should sanction the renewal of their registration in the following year.

**The Club cannot afford the risk of the system being abused and the subsequent loss of the benefits of these worthwhile concessions for other Club members.**

vehicles of the day, I'd like to own.

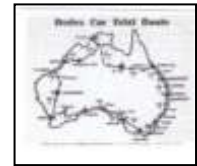

# LOOKING BACK Redex Trials of the 1950's



The start of the Redex Legend that originated in 1953 "Redex Reliability Trial," remains as a watershed in endurance rallies in Australia. Up to that time it was the second longest trial ever staged in the world (the previous longest had been from New York to Paris in 1908)

The Redex Reliability trial that was held in 1953 was at a time when the majority of Australia's roads either didn't exist or were in a poor state of repair. Even the Melbourne to Sydney stint, which is considered a fairly easy Drive today, was hard going for the drivers with dusty tracks serving as roads in place of modern motorways.



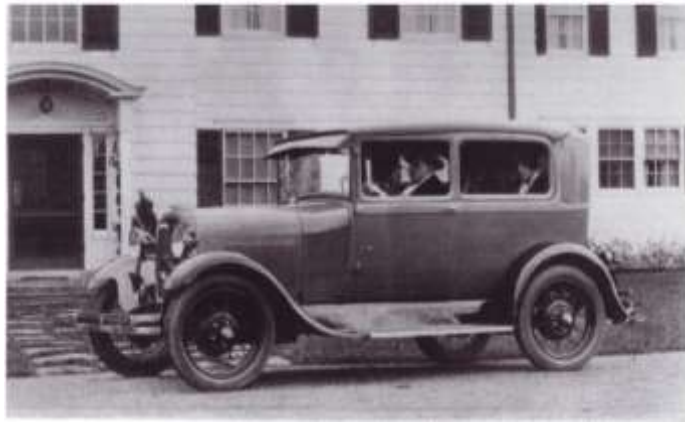
## The Round Australia Trial

The Round Australia Trial was a motorsport rally which was ran on multiple occasions between 1953 and 1998. The theme of the event was to stage a rally which circumnavigated Australia.

90 years ago

The two millionth Model A Ford rolled off the production line. Also called the A, & A-bone among rodders and customers, this automobile was the second huge success for the Ford Motor Company, after the predecessor, the model A. Prices for the models ranged from US \$385 for a roadster to us \$1400 for the top of the line town car.

The engine was a water cooled L-head in line 4-cylinder with a top speed of around 65 mph (105 km/h). The transmission was a conventional 3-speed sliding gear manual unsynchronised unit with a single speed reverse. The model A had 4 wheel mechanical drum brakes. The 1930 and 31 models were available with stainless steel radiator cowlings and headlamp housings.

The model A came in a wide variety of styles including a Coupe, (Standard & Deluxe) Business Coupe, Sports Coupe, Roadster Coupe, (Standard & Deluxe), Convertible cabriolet, Convertible Sedan, Phaeton (Standard & Deluxe), Town Car Four Door (2 window) (Standard & Deluxe), Four Door (3 window) Standard & Deluxe), Victoria, Station Wagon, Truck and commercial.

The Model A was the first to use the standard set of driver controls with conventional clutch & brake pedals, throttle and gearshift. Previous Fords used that had become uncommon to drivers of other makes. The Model A's fuel tank was situated in the cowl between the engine compartment's fire wall and the dash panel. It had a visual fuel gauge and the fuel flowed to the carburetor by gravity. The Model A was the first to have safety glass in the windshield. The Model ended production in March 1932.

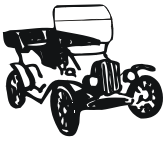

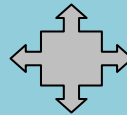

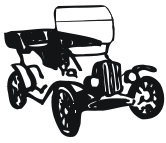
