	Registration / Historic Plates	Santo Penisi	Three membership applications lodged / passed: - 1. Paul Logan 2. Jarrod Middleton 3. Tom Coombs. Welcome to BCVC Inc. Santo reported that BCVC currently has 120 vehicles within the Club on Historic Registration. This figure has dropped significantly from previous years. Some BCVC members have left BCVC club to join neighbouring clubs; sold vehicles; health issues or moved from Ballina Shire. There are 35 car clubs in the North Coast area now. Santo stated that BCVC Inc. is closely adhering to RMS requirements re usage of classic vehicles / active club membership / classic vehicle plates as BCVC Inc. so that BCVC Inc. wouldn't be fined in the event of a full audit. Santo explained that all official business re registration of vehicles / membership applications will only be processed at BCVC Inc. Meetings & not at his place of business as previously practiced. BCVC Inc. will check that members who haven't as yet paid Membership Dues / Registered classic vehicles on historic plates comply as soon as possible. RMS policy / procedures have become more explicit re the usage of classic vehicles and the official RMS Log Book is essential when driving your classic vehicle. 90% Car Clubs are not conducting in-house inspections any more due to the imposition of excessive fines to the Rego Executive / Club itself. Some members intend to finalise Membership / Rego requirements after the meeting tonight. It is necessary to have all BCVC Inc. paperwork / Pink Slip / Insurance completed for filing at the time of payment. David Felsch acknowledged Santo's involvement with BCVC Inc. for some 40 years all members joined David in acclamation of his ongoing contribution.	2.3.2021
